

○ What is Schoology?

- Schoology is a virtual learning platform where students and teachers create, manage, and share classroom content.

○ What is Schoology used for?

- To increase student engagement and promote learning opportunities
- To expand synchronous and asynchronous student learning experiences
- To provide opportunities for communication and collaboration between home and school by assigning and collecting work electronically

○ How do I access Schoology?

- Beginning August 30, 2021 all teachers in grades 4-12 will use Schoology (pronounced /skoo-luh-jee/) - an online tool that serves as a one-stop shop for course information, assignments, grades and other learning related information. Teachers also use it to post updates to their classes and school administration may post important notifications such as upcoming events.
- Parents can register for a Schoology Account that is linked with their student's account. One username and password within Schoology grants access to your student's teachers, courses, school work and grades.
