



## Pleasant Valley Guidelines for Spectators at Athletic Events

### General Information:

- As per the Governor, spectators are allowable if the limits on gatherings **do not exceed 15% capacity of our high school gymnasium (363) and 20% capacity of our stadium (600)**. These numbers include the participants. Home and away spectators will be allowed at Pleasant Valley facilities along with essential personnel for each sport. Visiting spectators will be allowed for events as long as they present a school issued pass and adhere to the guidelines regarding the number allowable set below. No one will be permitted on the premises without a school issued pass or ticket.
  - o Essential Personnel (visitors)
    - Coaches, Players, Athletic Trainers, Bus Drivers, Videographer(s), and Administration (limited to 6).
    - Visiting spectators will present a school issued pass at the gate. The number allowable will depend on the sport. Administrative passes should only be provided to members of athletic administration or school district administration.
    - The visiting school will provide the host school with total number of people they will be bringing along with the number of buses by Wednesday of game week. (Football Only).
    - No visiting band or cheerleaders will be permitted (Football Only)
    - A minimum of 2 / maximum of 4 home spectator passes will be provided to each home student athlete for stadium / gymnasium sports.
- Teams will be required to bring their own means of hydration.
- All recommended health and safety protocols issued by the CDC, PIAA, and PDE are to be followed. This includes appropriate wearing of a mask.
- Visiting locker rooms will not be provided. Restrooms will be available.
- Team Buses will be parked close by in the event of severe weather.

### Spectators by Sport:

- **Varsity Football**- Each Pleasant Valley participant (player, coach, cheerleader, and band member) will be issued (2) two tickets each for home games. Visiting players will be allowed (1) one pass per player.
- **JV / Freshman Football**- Each Pleasant Valley player and coach will be provided (4) four tickets to be distributed to family members. Each Pleasant Valley cheerleader will be provided 2 tickets to be distributed to family members. Visiting players will be allowed (2) passes per player.

- **Varsity and JV Boys Soccer, Girls Soccer, and Field Hockey**- Each Pleasant Valley participant will be provided (4) four tickets to be distributed to family members. Visiting players will be allowed (2) passes per player.
- **Varsity Cross Country and Girls Tennis**- Home and Visitor spectators are permitted. Spectators should follow CDC guidelines and be socially distant
- **Girls Volleyball**- Each Pleasant Valley participant will be provided (4) four tickets to be distributed to family members. Visiting players will be allowed (2) two passes per player. All spectators will have their temperature checked upon entering the gym. If anyone's temperature reads higher than 100.4 they will be asked to wait 15 minutes and their temperature will be checked again. If their temperature continues to read higher than 100.4 they will then be asked to leave the premises. If it is lower than 100.4 they will be allowed to enter.
- **Varsity Cheerleading**- Each cheerleader will be provided (2) two tickets to distribute to family members when performing at home varsity football games.
- **JV/Freshman Cheerleading**- Each cheerleader will be provided (2) two passes to be distributed to family members when performing at home JV/Freshman football games.
- **Band**- Each band member will be provided (2) two tickets to distribute to family members when performing at home football games.
- **Middle School Girls Volleyball**- Each Pleasant Valley participant will be provided (4) four tickets to be distributed to family members. Visiting players will be allowed (2) two passes per player. Middle school matches will be played at the high school. All spectators will have their temperature checked upon entering the gym. If anyone's temperature reads higher than 100.4 they will be asked to wait 15 minutes and their temperature will be checked again. If their temperature continues to read higher than 100.4 they will then be asked to leave the premises. If it is lower than 100.4 they will be allowed to enter.
- **All Other Middle School Sports**- Home and away spectators are permitted. Passes will NOT be provided for home or visiting athletes. Spectators should follow CDC guidelines, be socially distant, and wear a mask.

### Stadium/Gymnasium Protocols for Spectators

1. Temperature checks (Gymnasium only)- Temperatures will be checked upon entering the gymnasium. If anyone's temperature reads higher than 100.4 they will be asked to wait 15 minutes and their temperature will be checked again. If their temperature continues to read higher than 100.4 they will then be asked to leave the premises. If it is lower than 100.4 they will be allowed to enter.
2. Families may sit together, but must be socially distanced from others in both the gymnasium and the stadium.

4. Spectators are encouraged to remain in their seating area and only leave to use the restrooms.
