The Pleasant Valley School District issues Pennsylvania work permits to all minors who reside in the school district. To obtain a PA work permit from the school district:

1. The student must be planning to work in Pennsylvania. Other states, including New York and New Jersey do not have reciprocal work arrangements and a work permit must be obtained from the school district where the employer is located in that state.
2. The student must be a resident of the Pleasant Valley School District. If the student is not a school district resident, he or she should obtain a work permit from the school district in which they reside. Note: If the student is living out of state and working within the Pleasant Valley School District, the school district can issue a work permit.
3. The student and parent/guardian will need to come to the main office of the high school, and obtain and submit the proper application form.
4. The student needs to produce an original or copy of their birth certificate, baptismal certificate, passport or photo driver's license before obtaining a work permit.
5. A parent or guardian must be present in order to obtain a work permit.

IMPORTANT! The student must be present when the work permit is issued and a signature of parent or guardian must be executed at the high school main office at the time of issuance or signature must be notarized on an attestation document. **This is a state mandate.**
