Attention Students: Our lost and found is overflowing with items and will be emptied this Friday, November 9th. Please stop in to the office to claim your belongings.



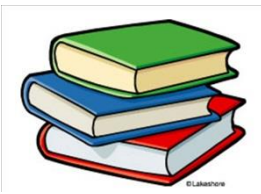
