



Dear Parent/Guardian,

The Math Department at Pleasant Valley Middle School is excited to be partnering with Imagine Learning this year to enhance our students' learning experience. Imagine Learning is a computer-based supplemental math program which differentiates lessons based upon the needs of each individual student. Students will automatically be entered into a learning pathway based on their grade level. Each student will take a short benchmark test which will determine their learning pathway. This pathway adjusts to include lessons that students struggled with on the benchmark. Pathways can also be adjusted for those students who are excelling on the lessons. Imagine Learning addresses gaps in students' learning and helps them become proficient on grade level lessons and beyond.

Students will be required to complete 3 lessons per week (Monday - Sunday) and hand in journal pages for each lesson completed. This will count as a homework grade in their math classes. They will have the opportunity to utilize the program during WIN periods when they are scheduled with a math teacher. Students may also access the program during period 10 if they choose to do so. Students are responsible for completing lessons at home if they are not completed during school time.

Please review the attached information with your child. If you have any questions, do not hesitate to email or call your child's math teacher.

## **How does my child access Imagine Learning at home?**

## **What is included in each lesson?**

Each lesson includes a pre-quiz, a game, a lesson and a post quiz.

## **What should my child write on the journal papers?**

The journal papers should be used like scrap paper. Students do not need to write down the questions, but they do need to show all of their work in each box. Journal pages must be completed in order for your child to receive credit.

## **What happens if my child passes the pre-quiz?**

If your child passes the pre-quiz, that lesson will be considered completed and passed.

## **What happens if my child doesn't pass the post quiz?**

If students do not pass the post quiz, they will have to complete the lesson again. If they do not pass the post quiz a second time, the lesson will be moved to the bottom of the pathway. Sometimes, if it is a prerequisite skill that is preventing the student from passing, the pathway will adjust to add prerequisite lessons.

## **What should my child do if he/she is struggling with a lesson?**

If your child is struggling on a lesson they may:

1. ask his/her math teacher
2. press the hint button on the screen
3. access a live teacher on the Imagine Learning site

**When are live teachers available on the site?**

Monday - Thursday: 7:30am - 9:30pm

Friday: 7:30am - 6:30 pm

Saturday: 9am - 1pm

Sunday: 5:30pm - 9:30pm

**If my child completes less than the number of required lessons, will they receive partial credit?**

Yes.
