

PLEASANT VALLEY SCHOOL DISTRICT

**Resolution Authorizing Proposed Preliminary Budget
Display and Advertising and Authorizing Referendum Exception**


RESOLVED, by the Board of School Directors of Pleasant Valley School District, as follows:

1. The School District shall make the 2020-2021 Proposed Preliminary Budget available for public inspection at least 20 days before the date scheduled for adoption of the Preliminary Budget.
2. At least 10 days before the date scheduled for adoption of the Preliminary Budget, the Secretary shall advertise a **Preliminary Budget Notice**. The notice shall be advertised once in a newspaper of general circulation and shall be posted at the School District offices.
3. Monroe County has undergone a revised assessment of real property values. The 2020-2021 budget will be the first time the school district will levy its real estate taxes on that revised assessment. The percentage increase in taxes levied for 2020-2021 shall be limited to the adjusted Act 1 Index as calculated by the Pennsylvania Department of Education for the prior year, 2019-2020.
4. The adjusted Act 1 index applicable to the School District as calculated by the Pennsylvania Department of Education is 3.2%. The Preliminary Budget Proposal assumes that the School District will receive approval for use of one or more Act 1 real estate tax referendum exceptions. The School District shall take all steps required to obtain approval for the referendum exceptions contemplated in the Preliminary Budget Proposal, including advertising once in a newspaper of general circulation and placing on the School District internet website **Act 1 Referendum Exception Notice**.
