- Yes: 300 responses
- No: 9 responses
- Sometimes: 62 responses

- Parent Advisory Council Meetings: 8 responses
- Parent-Teacher Conferences: 287 responses

3. Are you aware of what your child is expected to understand in all subject areas?

- Yes: 260 responses
- No: 24 responses
- Somewhat: 94 responses

4. How often does your child's teacher communicate with you about your child's progress?

- I hear from my child's teacher occasionally.: 150 responses
- I hear from my child's teacher regularly. :182 responses
