**Our first inductee to the 2016 Pleasant Valley Hall of Fame:
Mr. Tony Yazbeck**

Tony attended Pleasant Valley from 1993 through 1995. He attended Point Park University and The Cincinnati College- Conservatory of Music. Tony also taught “Master Classes” in acting for the Pleasant Valley Drama Department.

Honors Received

While at Pleasant Valley, Tony was awarded “perfect attendance” and was a straight A student. He also starred in the musical productions of “Godspell” and “The Sound of Music” as well as participating in basketball.

Jason graduated from Pleasant Valley High School in 1977. While in high school Jason was a three year letter winner in football and a four year letter winner in track and field. He was also a member of the Varsity Club.

Honors Received

In football, Jason was named captain of the football team in 1977 and helped to lead the team to the best record ever at Pleasant Valley with a record of 10 wins and 1 loss.

In Track, Jason was named Trackman of the Year in 1977. Upon graduation he held the school record for the 220, the 440, the long jump and the triple jump. He was also the Centennial League champion in the 220 and the 440. He was also the 1st Pleasant Valley athlete to be named a district champion when he won the 440 at the District XI track meet. He qualified for states and came in 11th place in the 440 in Shippensburg.

Jason has worked for the Pleasant Valley School District for the past twenty years. He has been the Head of Maintenance for the past eighteen years. Jason currently resides in Effort, PA with Brenda his wife of twenty years. He has a son, Garrett, who is currently in 8th grade at Pleasant Valley.

Our 4th inductee this evening to the 2016 Pleasant Valley Hall of Fame: Mr. Justin C. Kashner

Honors Received

Justin was named to the 2nd team All-State football team for kicker and was a Pocono Record 1st team All-Star. In baseball as a pitcher, Justin was named first team in both the Pocono Record and the Morning Call. He was also named the Baseball Player of the Year for both the Pocono Record and the Morning Call as well as named to the Toyota All Pennsylvania Baseball team. Justin also participated in many clubs while attending Pleasant Valley.

While attending the West Point Military Academy, Justin was a four year starter as a pitcher. He was a two time All Patriot League Pitcher and recorded a win in the NCAA Tournament vs. South Alabama. He was also awarded numerous medals while serving in the United States Army. These included: The Bronze Star, the Combat Action Badge, two Army commendation medals, two Iraq Campaign Service medals, four Army Achievement medals, two overseas ribbons, the Global War on Terrorism medal, the National Defense Service medal and the Army Service Ribbon.

Our 5th inductee this evening to the 2016 Pleasant Valley Hall of Fame: Mr. Trevor Micklos

Trevor graduated from Pleasant Valley High School in 2000. He went on to attend Lehigh University where he earned his BS in Business and Marketing in 2004. He then attended Moravian College and earned his Master's in Business Administration in Healthcare Management in 2009.

Honors Received

While at Pleasant Valley, Trevor was a four year letter winner in football during which he set numerous records and was named to many honors. Trevor was named 1st team All-Conference Quarterback and Defensive Back for the MVC in 1999. He combined for over 2000 yards in offense his senior year, and accumulated 5,000 yards of offense in his career at Pleasant Valley. He was a two year captain; Scholar Athlete, Channel 13 player of the week, twice named the Times News player of the week, and also named to the Pocono Record All Area team for defense. He participated in the McDonalds All Star game where he was named the Player of the Game for setting records for number of touchdowns and passing yards. He was also a member of the National Honor Society at Pleasant Valley and the 1999 Lehigh Valley Scholar Athlete nominee for the National Football Foundation.

While attending Lehigh University, Trevor was a three year letter winner in football. As a defensive back for the team, he led the team in interceptions and was 2nd in tackles. He was named the Lehigh University Special Teams player of the year in 2002. In 2002, he was a member of the Patriot League Championship team and Lambert Cup as well as the recipient of the National Football Hall of Fame Scholar Leader Athlete Award.

Trevor enjoys skiing and also works with COACH which is the Community Outreach by Athletes that Care about Helping. Trevor currently is the Regional Director of Operations for Coordinated Health. He lives in Easton, PA with his wife of three years, Corrine. He has a daughter Josetta.
