


COVID-19 DECISION TREE – Close Contact – No Symptoms (10/14/21)



- People fully vaccinated who provide their official vaccination card can attend work/school.
- People who were previously diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last three months can attend work/school unless symptoms develop. When quarantine begins (day 1 of quarantine begins day after notice of quarantine):
- If an individual is sent home from school/work with 3 or more symptoms or a parent/staff member calls and says child is staying home due to symptoms or staff report same, contact tracing begins that day and those fitting close contact definition begin quarantine unless they fit under the exemptions listed above or a decision in the chart says they do not have to quarantine.
- If we have a report of a positive test and did not know the individual had any symptoms, contact tracing goes back <u>two</u> days prior to the report of a positive test and those needed to quarantine according to the decision trees will do so.
- If you decide to test your child for COVID on your own, they must stay at home while awaiting results.
